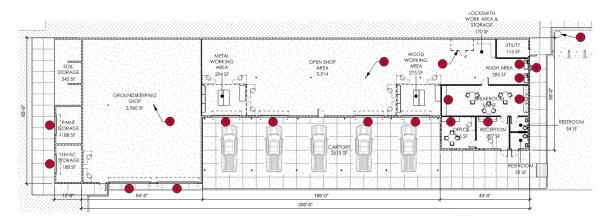
- 3. District Central Kitchen (Non-Measure Q Project):

#### 4. District M&O Facility (Non-Measure Q Project)::

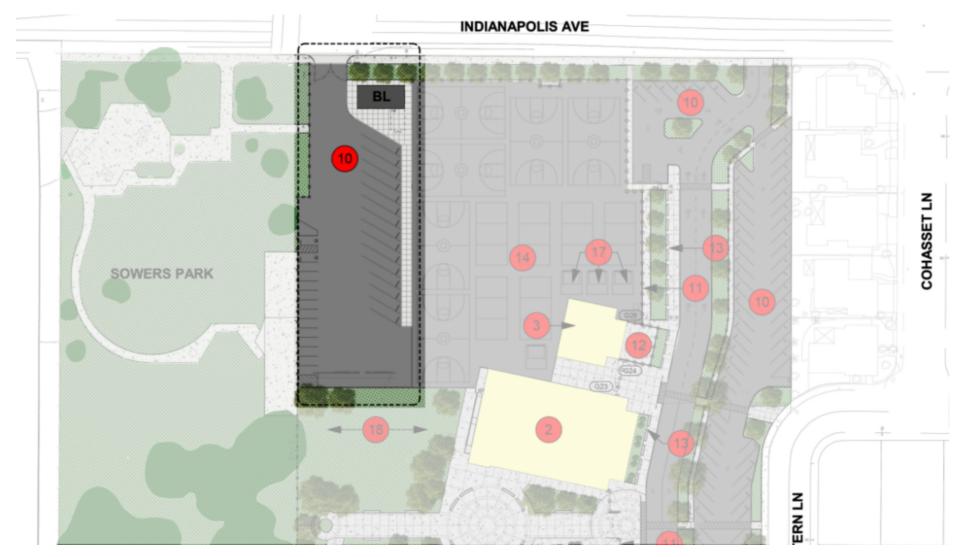
- Schematic Design has been completed including meetings with constituents

<sup>\*</sup> The District anticipates \$4,072,728 of state matching funds by early 2023. The remaining state matching funds of \$7,861,819 remain on the unfunded list of projects pending state bond authority. These funds must be utilized on school facility improvements.
